



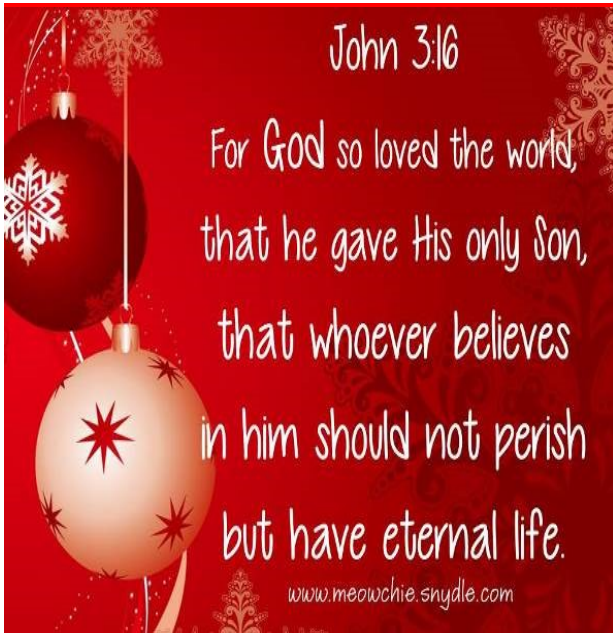

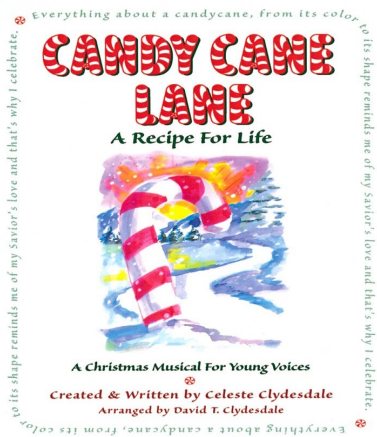

Please join us on Wednesday, December 14th at 6:30pm, as our students take us on an exciting journey to "Candy Cane Lane ..... A Recipe For Life"

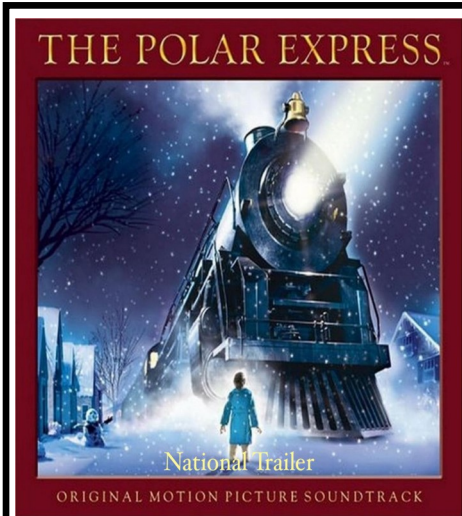
