



FCCS ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

WHO CAN APPLY

At Family Christian Center School, we empower parents with the academic resources and information needed to choose the right Christ-Centered school for their children. All 6th grade-12th grade students looking to attend Family Christian Center School in the coming year can apply for the FCCS merit-based Academic Scholarship tuition assistance program. Certain criteria has been established as outlined below. All qualified applicants will be considered.

These highly competitive scholarships are awarded on the basis of achievement rather than need. Students must demonstrate an exceptional level of performance in academics combined with community service and other in-school and after-school activities.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES/HOW IT WORKS

The FCCS Academic Scholarship is open to all middle and high school students attending FCCS in the coming year who meet the following criteria:

- Our FCCS Academic Scholarship is merit-based combined with extra-curricular activities. It is open to students from 6th grade-12th grade. To apply, students must have a GPA of 3.2 - 4.0.
- Students cannot apply for this scholarship if already using tuition support from another source to attend FCCS or are attending FCCS at a reduced tuition.
- Students must write a 500-word essay and participate in a short interview. An appointment must be arranged to complete this at FCCS prior to submitting the application.
- The FCCS Academic Scholarship must only be used to cover tuition expenses.
- The FCCS Academic Scholarship is for one school year only.
- If the Student meets the qualifications at the time of application, Students may re-apply in subsequent years, even if they have already received OR have been denied this scholarship in previous years.
- The FCCS Academic Scholarship application requests and encourages applicants to include their community service, Christ-Centered activities, organized athletics, Clubs, National Honor Society, and any other in-school or after-school activities.

DEADLINE

Applications must be submitted by April 21, 2018 at 11:00 PM EST to be considered for the 2018-19 academic year. Recipients will be notified by May 10, 2018.
